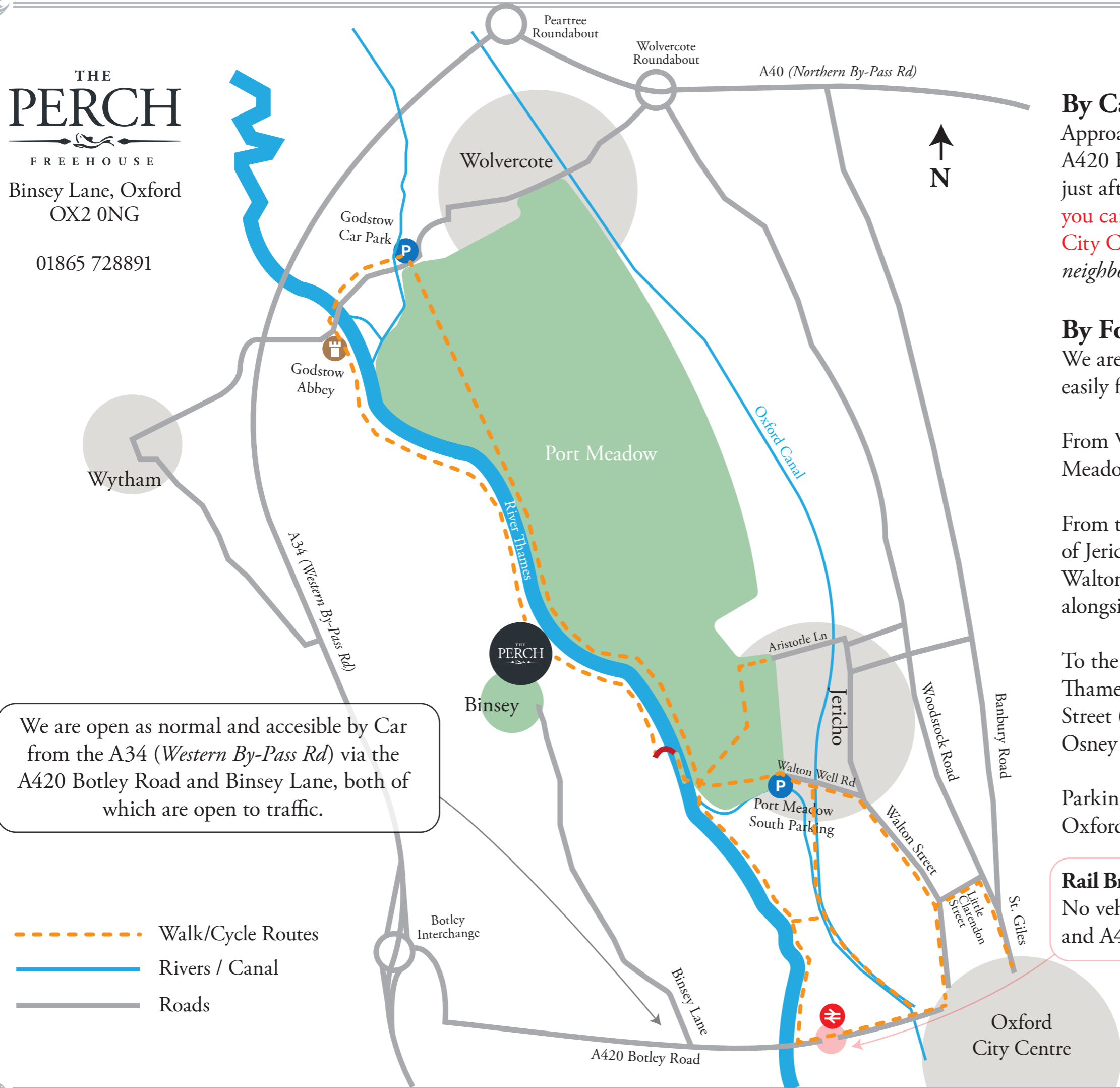

We are open as normal and accesible by Car from the A34 (*Western By-Pass Rd*) via the A420 Botley Road and Binsey Lane, both of which are open to traffic.

By Car

Approach Oxford from the West, along the A420 Botley Road, turn left up Binsey Lane just after Waitrose. **Due to Rail Bridge Closure, you cannot drive to the Perch from Oxford City Centre.** Please be courteous to our neighbours when parking if our car park is full.

By Foot or Bike

We are on the Thames Path and can be reached easily from all directions on either foot or bike.

From Wolvercote you can walk across Port Meadow on either side of the river.

From the City Centre head north to the suburb of Jericho to join Port Meadow at the end of Walton Well Road or Aristotle Lane and walk alongside the river to reach us.

To the west of the City Centre you can join the Thames Path north from either Hythe Bridge Street (*starting along the Oxford Canal*) or from Osney Bridge on Botley Road.

Parking is available in Jericho, Wolvercote and Oxford City Centre.
